

PUBLIC NOTICE

It is hereby informed to all the recognised teacher education institutions to comply with the Rules and Regulations of NCTE as per the directions/instructions given below :-

A. INSTRUCTION REGARDING LAND DOCUMENTS :-

As per the clause 8(7) of NCTE regulations 10.12.2007 (Regulations, Norms and Procedure) the land shall be in the name of the institution either on ownership basis or on the lease from the Government/Govt. Institution for a period of not less than 30 years, In cases where under relevant State / UT Administration law shall prevail. However, no building could be taken on lease for running any teacher training course. The land shall be free from all encumbrances.

Therefore, all the recognized institution are required for compliance to the above norms strictly under clause 8(7) of the regulation 2007 and must submit the land documents accordingly within 30 days from the date of issue of this notice.

B. INSTRUCTION REGARDING ENDOWMENT FUND & RESERVE FUND :-

It is hereby informed that all recognized teacher education institutions are essentially required to maintain the following funds in the form of fixed deposit as per NCTE Regulations 2005 and Regulations 2009.

- a. Endowment fund of Rs 5 Lakhs (Rupees Five Lakhs) per course / per unit.**
- b. Reserve fund of Rs 3 Lakhs (Rupees Three Lakhs) per course / per unit.**

For maintenance of endowment fund and reserve fund as mentioned above the institution shall submit two separate FDRs, for 5 years (60 Months) within one month from the receipt of recognition order, into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee from a nationalized bank.

In view of the above it is hereby informed that all the recognized institutions are required to submit the original FDRs, in joint operation to the office of NRC (NCTE), Jaipur within 30 days from date of issue of this notice.

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C. INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING SHIFTING FROM TEMPORARY PREMISES(RENTED) TO THE PERMANENT PREMISES (BUILDING) :-

All the recognized institutions which are running in rented/temporary premises even after completion of three years/session are hereby directed to shift to their permanent premises immediately with the prior approval of NRC (NCTE), failing which the recognition granted to the institutions stands cancelled automatically from the next academic session

In this connection all the recognized institutions are required to send their compliance report within 30 days from issue of this notice.

D. INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING NAAC ACCREDITATION :-

As per the clause 8(5) of NCTE regulations 10.12.2007 all the institutions which have been granted recognition for additional intake in B.Ed and B.P.Ed. Courses after promulgations of Regulations 2005 that is 13.1.2006 shall have to be accredited itself with the **National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC)** with a **Letter Grade B** under the new grading system developed by NAAC **before 1st April 2010** failing which the additional intake granted shall **stand withdrawn w.e.f. academic session 2010-2011 automatically.**

In this connection Institutions may approach the Regional coordinator, NAAC or visit the website of NAAC (www.naacindia.org).

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
