The Society/Trust has submitted an application through online mode on 28/12/2012 and physical application has been received in the office of NRC on 01/02/2013 for B.Ed. course in the proposed institution, by Natthu Singh Degree College, Plot No. 68, Khasara No. 107, Street Number- 1, Village/Town- Karanpur, Post office- Aliyabad, Tehsil/Taluka- Thakurdwara, Town/City- Thakurdwara, State- UP, District- Moradabad(UP), Pin Code -244401. The said application has been processed by the NRC, NCTE as per provisions contained in the NCTE Regulations, 2009 and amendments made thereto from time to time. It is informed that on preliminary perusal of the documents submitted with your application viz-a-viz provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2009, your application is found deficient on the following points which are as under:-

- i. Originally notarized change of land use (CLU) certificate issued by SDM under Section 143 of the U.P. Land Act not submitted.
- ii. Building plan does not show for which teacher education course the building has been constructed.
- iii. The name of the institution given in the building plan and Land document does not match with the application.
- iv. The built up area for the proposed course is not clear from the building plan.
- v. Total land area in Land document does not match with the application.
- vi. Affiliating body not mentioned by the institution in the application form.
- vii. FDRs of Rs. 5 lakhs towards endowment fund and Rs. 3 lakhs towards reserve fund in original of the nationalized bank not submitted.
- viii. Khasara no. in the Affidavit does not match with the application.
- ix. Dates of registration in the Affidavit do not match with the application.
- x. Information at s.no. 3 of the Affidavit not given.
- xi. The institution has been granted recognition for B.Ed. course on 28/12/2012. As per Clause 8(3) of NCTE Regulations 2009, an institution can apply for one basic unit only of an additional course or for an additional unit of the existing recognized course after completion of three academic sessions of the respective course, for which the Institution shall submit application before the cut off date prescribed for submission of applications in the year succeeding the completion of three academic sessions. Hence, clarification be given.
- xii. The institution is also required to submit on Affidavit on Rs 100/- Stamp Paper as per format enclosed in support of information required as per clause 8(2), 8(3) and 8(7) (2) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009 and Page-2, 4 and 5 of the online Application form,
- 2. You are advised to remove/make good the above deficiencies within a period of 60 days. It may be noted by the institution that it is the sole responsibility of the institution to ensure proper compliance of all the essential documents as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules

- 3. Your reply/representation along with all necessary documents must be submitted within 60 days of issue of this letter, failing which appropriate action will be taken as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations.
- 4. Reply in piece meal will not be accepted. Since application has been processed as per clause 6 of the NCTE Regulation 2009, hence once the application is duly processed by this office, the claim for refund of application/ processing fee cannot be made at any stage of application, whatsoever be the crass
