- CLU submitted is not originally notaraized. Originally notarized change of land use (CLU) certificate issued by SDM under Section 143 of U.P. Land Act is to be submitted.
- FDRs of Rs. 5 lakhs towards Endowment Fund and Rs. 3 lakhs towards Reserve Fund in original from ii. nationalized bank not submitted.
- iii. Information at s.no. 2.2 i.e. District name & Village name in the affidavit does not match with the application.
- The address (plot no.) of the Trust given in the Trust Decd does not match with the application. iv.
- Total land area & khasara nos. given in the application do not match with the land documents. ν.
- νi. Total land area & khasara nos. given in the CLU certificate does not match with the application.
- Trust name given in the CLU certificate does not match with the application. vii.
- viii. Total built-up area given in the building plan does not match with the application.
- The building plan not approved by the Competent Authority/Local Body. ix.
- Building plan does not show for which teacher education course the building has been constructed. x.
- Name of the Trust in the Affidavit does not match with the application. хi.
- The institution is also required to submit on Affidavit on Rs 100/- Stamp Paper as per format enclosed in support of information required as per clause 8(2), 8(3) and 8(7) (2) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009 and Page-2, 4 and 5 of the online Application form.
- You are advised to remove/make good the above deficiencies within a period of 60 days. It may be noted by the institution that it is the sole responsibility of the institution to ensure proper compliance of all the essential documents as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations.
- Your reply/representation along with all necessary documents must be submitted within 60 days of issue of this letter, failing which appropriate action will be taken as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations.
- Reply in piece meal will not be accepted. Since application has been processed as per clause 6 of the NCTE Regulation 2009, hence once the application is duly processed by this office, the claim for refund of application/ processing fee cannot be made at any stage of application, whatsoever be the case.
