The said application has been processed by the NRC, NCTE as per provisions contained in the NCTE Regulation 2009. It is informed that on preliminary perusal of the documents submitted with your application viz a viz provisions of the NCTE Regulation, 2009, your application is found deficient on the following points which are as under:-

FDRs submitted is not from nationalized/Scheduled Bank.

Certified copy of registered land documents issued by the competent authority (office of Registrar/Sub ii. Registrar) as required under provision of NCTE regulation, 2009 has not submitted.

The institution has not submitted approved building plan in original. The original building plan approved by competent authority indicating name of Institution, name of the course, Khasra No./Plot No. of land, total land area & built up area, size of multipurpose hall, class rooms, library, different resource centre etc as per NCTE norms for the proposed course is required to be submitted.

Notarized copy of change of land use certificate issued under clause 143 of UP land Act by the iv. competent authority has not submitted.

Affidavit in the prescribed format on Rs.100/ stamp paper duly attested by oath commissioner or Notary Public as required under provision of section 7(1) of NCTE, Regulation, 2009 has not been submitted.

The Institution has submitted print out of the on line application, which is not a valid print out of the νi. application, Hence the institution is required to submit on line application.

The specific information of land/ building, demarcated area as required in clause 8(7)(ii) and vii. information required under clause 8(2) 8(3) of NCTE Regulations 2009 and information related to resolution of the society for opening the said course not for profit etc has not given by the institution hance the same is required from the institution in the affidavit(format of the affidavit is enclosed

You are advised to remove/make good of the above deficiencies within a period of 60 days failing which your application will be treated as rejected and closed. It may be noted by the institution it is the sole responsibility of the institution to ensure proper compliance of all the essential documents as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules &

Your reply/representation alongwith all necessary documents accompanied with an Affidavit in support of the reply of the above points must be submitted within 60 days of issue of this letter, failing which appropriate action will be taken as per provisions of the NCTE Rules & Regulations.

Reply in piece meal will not be accepted. Since application has been processed as per clause 6 of Regulation 2009, hence once the application is duly processed by this office, the claim for refund of application/processing fee cannot be made at any stage of application, whatsoever be the case.
